





### Costa Rica

### Thailand

### Uniting for Mangrove Conservation and a Sustainable Future!

Jitawesomes in Thailand dedicated time at the Samut Sakhon Mangrove Forest Research Center for a conservation event aimed at restoring the local mangrove ecosystem.
