

Intuit Enterprise Suite (IES) is designed for organizations that need advanced accounting and management capabilities. It offers tools for tracking projects, managing grants and restricted funds, and generating detailed financial reports. With features that support more complex financial processes, IES is well-suited for organizations that have outgrown QuickBooks Online (QBO) and are seeking to use a less cumbersome user interface than Intacct or Blackbaud.
